

Modoc LAFCo NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING

A reorganization consisting of the formation of County Service Area 2 (CSA 2) and the dissolution of the Lookout Pest Abatement District (Modoc LAFCo File No 2023-0001)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Modoc Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) will hold a public protest hearing on July 14, 2023 at the Modoc City Hall Council Chambers 200 North Street, Alturas, CA. to receive written protest against the formation of County Service Area 2 (CSA 2) including the unincorporated area in Modoc County and the dissolution of the Lookout Pest Abatement District detachment consisting of 18,832 acres more or less. The resolutions including a map of the LPAD territory to be dissolved and the formation of CSA 2 (reorganized) are accessible from LAFCo website www.Modoclafco.org

Owners of property and voters residing within the annexation territory may now file written protests against this proposal until the close of the protest hearing on July 14, 2023.

Proceedings for this proposal were initiated by the Board of Supervisors on May 23, 2023. The Modoc Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) approved the proposal, which will be effective upon recordation of the Certificate of Completion. The hearing will **BEGIN at 10:00 a.m. and END at 10:15 a.m. on July 14, 2023** at the Modoc City Hall Council Chambers 200 North Street, Alturas, CA

To be counted, protests must be in writing with an original signature. They must be submitted before the close of the hearing, and they must be signed by owners of land and (or) by registered voters residing within the subject reorganized territory. A form is printed below for the convenience of anyone wishing to file a protest; it may be copied or filled in, detached, signed, and returned to LAFCo.

Protests may be mailed to Modoc LAFCo, P.O. Box 2694 Granite Bay, CA 95746 or delivered to the LAFCo Executive Officer or his designee at the protest hearing. Each protest must clearly state whether it is made by a landowner or a registered voter or submitted for both and must include the name and address of the person submitting it and original signature. Landowner protests must also include a street address or Assessor's parcel number identifying the location of the property in question. A registered voter's protest must show the voter's name and residence address as it appears on the affidavit of registration.

The value of protests received and not withdrawn before the hearing concludes will be determined within 30 days following the hearing in accordance with Government Code Section 57075. For more information, please call the LAFCo office at (530) 619-5128.
